



# **Cecil College and Stevenson University**

## Associate to Bachelors Program in Nursing

## **General Requirements:**

- Students must meet application requirements for Cecil College (CC) as a degree-seeking student during the time they are enrolled in the AS degree portion of the curriculum.
- Students must meet the application requirements for Stevenson University (SU) as a degree-seeking student during the entire time they are enrolled in the Associate to Bachelor (ATB).
- Students must be dually enrolled at CC and SU for the time period during which they are earning their AS degree in Nursing.
- Students must meet programmatic screening requirements established by mutual consent of the two institutions for full acceptance into the ATB.
- Students must meet programmatic progression policy requirements to meet academic rigor throughout matriculation. Procedures regarding disciplinary action and, as warranted, program dismissal will be established by SU and CC to insure compliance.
- The AS degree will be awarded by CC upon successful completion of the nursing AS degree requirements.
- Students must pass the NCLEX-RN® examination prior to enrollment in SU NURS 424: Health in the Community.
- The BS degree will be awarded by SU upon successful completion of the BS degree requirements.

### **Admissions:**

- Students will complete an application for admission into CC and pay all appropriate application fees to CC.
  Students will sign a statement granting permission to forward applications and/or related documents lo
  SU if necessary.
- Students interested in the ATB option will then complete the appropriate admission process for consideration of acceptance into SU. SU does not guarantee admission to any student; all students wishing to matriculate to SU shall be subject to all of SU's university and departmental admissions criteria.

#### **Tuition and Fees:**

 CC nursing students and nursing alumni will receive a 20% discount on SU tuition specifically for the ATB, RNBS, and/or RNMS options. This discount does not apply to SU student fees, books, or supplies.
