### ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR SOCIOLOGY-ANTHROPOLOGY, CRIMINAL JUSTICE CONCENTRATION

- Criminal Justice Concentration requires a minimum of 45 units, of which 24 must be upper (300-400) level.
- A minimum of 27 of the required total units in the Criminal Justice Concentration must be earned at TU.
- Students may replace a Sociology or Anthropology elective with an approved Optional Advanced Learning Experience Course. You may find a list of approved Optional Advanced Learning Experience courses in TU's most recent Course Catalog.

**BACHELOR'S DEGREE REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL STUDENTS**

- A grade C (2.0 GPA) or higher is required in all major courses and prerequisites.
- A cumulative GPA of 2.0 is required.
- 32 units of the bachelor's degree must be completed at the upper level (courses numbered 300 or above).

*\*Students may choose to fulfill three units of the Core Curriculum requirement for Core 9 by taking SOCI 300 Sociological Analysis, which could count towards the required coursework for the Sociology-Anthropology, Criminal Justice Concentration, but would not be counted in the unit total for the required coursework for the Criminal Justice Concentration in the above table. The Sociology-Anthropology, Criminal Justice Concentration at TU requires a minimum of 120 units for degree completion.*
