Program Information

Wilmington University will accept students from Cecil College who have earned an Associate of Science in Nursing degree, and who have completed additional credit hours at CC as specified on the attached transfer guide up to a maximum of 86 credit hours

Transfer Credit Hours

WilmU will accept a maximum of 86 credit hours from CC. All transferable courses must be at college level. A total of 16 credit hours from CC beyond the ADN as listed on the transfer guide will be accepted at WilmU as long as the students earn grades of "C" or higher.

Awarding of Bachelor's Degree

Graduates of CC who have completed the remaining 34 credit hours from WilmU will be awarded the BSN by Wilmington University.

Admission

WilmU will waive the standard admissions fee for CC students who are enrolled in the 3 + I program.
