### **RN to BSN Online**

Registered nurses who graduated from an accredited program and meet program requirements are eligible for direct articulation into the Nursing program.

- GPA above 2.0
- Active/unencumbered RN License
- Official transcript
- No prerequisites
  - Statistics is a requirement and will need to be completed prior to NUR 332
- 30 nursing credit hours must be taken at York College of Pennsylvania
  - General education credits may be taken elsewhere to graduate

The Online RN to BSN program was designed with working RNs in mind offering quality, affordability, flexibility and a short time to completion.

- 6 start dates per year
- 7-week courses with one-week break in between subsequent offerings
- Part-time and full-time options
- Designed to be completed in as little as 12 months
- 100% online
- Asynchronous classes

## **Tuition Costs:**

Students from partner institutions

- \$9,900 for the nursing curriculum (10 courses)
- \$330 per credit hour

Students from non-partner institutions

- \$12,000 for the nursing curriculum (10 courses)
- \$400 per credit hour
