## **Admissions Requirements**

Have successfully completed the program at the Sending Institution; Are enrolled in the Sending Institution, in good standing; Are accepted for admission to the Receiving Institution

## **Transfer of Academic Credit**

A Qualifying Student may transfer into from the Transferring Institution into the Receiving Institution for the completion of the Program.

Courses that the Receiving School will accept credits for towards completion of the Program have been outlined in the accompanying articulation guides that have been reviewed and agreed upon by both institutions.

Goldey-Beacom College (Receiving Institution) will accept up to 70 credits for a student from Cecil College (Sending Institution), including courses that meet General Education requirements.
